### Spring Parent Teacher Conferences will have a new format

As a staff we've been looking at ways to make the spring PTC sessions more meaningful for parents, students, and staff. Historically the spring sessions have had lower attendance rates so in an effort to make these sessions more meaningful, we've come up with a new format.

**Tuesday, March 3rd** will be our "traditional" PTC format where teachers will be available in the middle school commons from 5:00-8:00. Any parent will be able to come and visit with teachers about the progress of their student.
